	<p>Safeguarding means looking after your safety, health and how you feel.</p>
	<p>School must be a safe place for you, where you feel happy and you are treated well.</p>
	<p>You need to be able to share any worries. Adults should notice if you are not happy and must listen to you.</p>
	<p>Teachers must help you to learn how to keep yourself safe.</p>
	<p>You might feel worried or sad about something that happened at home, at school, on the internet, outside or at someone's house.</p>
	<p>If anyone, or anything is making you feel worried, sad or unsafe, it is not your fault.</p>
	<p>You should always tell someone if you are worried, even if someone tells you not to.</p>
	<p>You can talk to any adult at Ridgeway, but it is Lynn's job to make sure you are safe.</p>
